I am requesting that, in the course of the upcoming redistribution of Australian federal electorates, consideration be given to changing the name of the electorate of Denison to Inglis Clark.

Andrew Inglis Clark was one of the most important founders of Australian democracy as we now know it. Most of his contemporaries and colleagues in the movement to establish our federal democratic structures have been commemorated by having federal electorates named after them. It is time that such an honour devolved also on to Inglis Clark. Denison, named as it is after a colonial governor who was publicly opposed to the spread of democracy in the colony, would seem to be the most appropriate electorate to be named for him.
