Key information for enrolling and voting

- All Australian citizens 18 years and older must enrol to vote in elections and referendums.
- You need to let us know every time you change your address or your name.
- The AEC can enrol or update your address on the electoral roll based on information from other government agencies.

Access to enrolment information

To maintain the electoral roll, we can collect and verify your personal information. This is in line with the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918* (CEA). We may disclose electoral information to other parties under the CEA, including:

- the publicly available electoral roll (containing the names and addresses of voters), which you can view at AEC offices
- state and territory electoral authorities
- members of parliament, senators, registered political parties and candidates for the House of Representatives
- approved medical research and public health screening programs
- agencies, organisations or people prescribed in the *Electoral and Referendum Regulation 2016*.
