Hi Elizebeth,

Thanks for your information about the IPA acronym. Yes we can see how this objection might fall within the bounds of the sections 126 or 129 of the ACT.

The name of our proposed party is the Indigenous Aboriginal Party of Australia. However, we're unlikely to use an acronym at this stage because people will not know who we are talking about. The name Indigenous Party of Australia is a convenient abbreviation that people relate to but we are unlikely to use this acronym (and we are not wanting to register it).
