- This application form is for use by Political Campaigners who are required to register under section 287F of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918* (Electoral Act).
- Section 287F of the Electoral Act requires a person or entity to be registered as a political campaigner before the end of 90 days after becoming required to be registered.
- Section 292E of the Electoral Act requires each Political Campaigner to nominate a financial controller.
- Information on this form is collected under Sections 287K and 292F of the Electoral Act and some of the details contained in the form will be published on the Transparency Register on the [Australian Electoral Commission \(AEC\) website](#).
