

# Significant Third Party Disclosure Return

FINANCIAL YEAR 2023-24

Section 314AB(1) of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918* (Electoral Act) requires significant third parties to lodge a return within 16 weeks after the end of the financial year.

The due date for lodging this return is 21 October 2024.

Section 314AB(3A) of the Electoral Act requires significant third parties who are registered during the 2024-25 financial year to lodge a 2023-24 return within 30 days of registration.

## Completing the Return:

- This return is to be completed by the person who is nominated as the financial controller with the AEC.
- This return is to be completed with reference to the Financial Disclosure Guide for Significant Third Parties.
- Amounts should be reported on a GST inclusive basis.
- This return will be available for public inspection from 3 February 2025 at <a href="www.aec.gov.au">www.aec.gov.au</a>. The AEC is required to publish this return by s 320 of the Electoral Act. This means that any personal information contained within this return will be publicly available. Entities completing returns should ensure that any individuals named are properly informed about the publication of the return.
- Any supporting documentation included with this return may be treated as part of a public disclosure and displayed on the AEC website.
