I write on behalf of my community organisation the Craigieburn and District First Response Team Inc.

We are a legal Incorporated Association that has three statements of purposes, these are:

1. To provide a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) to the Craigieburn and wider community
2. To teach any member of the community basic first aid free of charge and
3. To fundraise for medical equipment for both local paramedics and patients

As the Team Leader of this organisation, I write to object to the proposed federal redistribution that would see our home town of Craigieburn divided down the centre.

To ensure community organisations and community members can receive a clear and consistent voice in Canberra our team feels that it is imperative that we are all represented by a single Federal Member of Parliament.
