Comment on Objections 87, 118, 98, 408

I live in St Kilda, and I don't agree with the objections that seek to split St Kilda East from Caulfield North and Caulfield. I never really go to Windsor, let alone South Yarra, and have nothing in common with people from Prahran or South Yarra.

I, and my neighbours go to Carlisle St and Balaclava Road, and I have far more in common with people in Caulfield and Caulfield North, and also Elwood and Elsternwick than I do with people in South Yarra.

The commission should not make such a radical change as splitting part of St Kilda East and Caulfield North from the rest of St Kilda and St Kilda East.

I also wanted to comment on Colin McLaren's objection to the name Macnamara. I would prefer Melbourne Ports to keep its name, but if it needs to change I think Balaclava is a far more meaningful name to the local community. However, I understand the AEC wants to move away from geographical names, so it should change the name of Macnamara to Holding, in recognition of Clyde Holding who was an outstanding member for Melbourne Ports, and much better than the current member.
