To Her Excellency Ms Quentin Bryce AC (via the Office thereof)

The most important duty of a Governor General of the Commonwealth of Australia is the issuing of writs to trigger the holding of a general election to determine the members of the House of Representatives of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia. Such an election should ascertain the collective will of the Nation. For the voter it translates into the surrender of individual sovereign legal power. Unfortunately as per the attached Election Petition with the Annexures minus the Exhibits a flawed counting system has meant that the said election has not been held and the associated command for the issuing of writs disobeyed. The said Election Petition was refused for filing by a High Court of Australia Justice. According to the High Court's own rules the only reason for such refusal is upon the grounds of frivolous or vexatious. It is not either, and is probably one of the most important and significant documents in Australian history. A Governor General has the power to command the High Court of Australia sitting as the Court of Disputed Returns to hear this Election Petition. The full implications and ramifications of this document is that most of statute law is invalid. Currently, the High Court of Australia and the Australian court system in general has been put in dishonour. With this letter and the attached Election Petition being now presented at a high legal/regal level, the Office of the Governor General of the Commonwealth of Australia has the opportunity to distinguish itself in honour or follow the High Court of Australia into dishonour. Although the Petition is self-explanatory it would be mutually beneficial if I as a Petitioner and Independent Federal candidate be granted an audience with the Governor General.
