

IMPORTANT REFUGEE HOUSING QUESTIONS? WILL VOTERS GET AN ANSWER?  
If we are to be a more sympathetic society to the plight of refugees, we need to think about their housing needs, where they will settle and ongoing employment opportunities.

Where will the extra refugee intake be housed. Most refugees to date are housed in our outer suburban and Regional areas, often with existing limited employment opportunities, leading to poor social outcomes. They are not settled in the leafy, expensive inner city suburbs where transport and employment opportunities are greater. Outer Melbourne is case in example.

Are new arrivals to be given first choice of our limited Public Housing positions?  
Should these refugees be given accommodation earmarked for our seniors, our veterans, our social disadvantaged, who may have been on a wait list for sometimes decades?

Who pays for the the increased social costs?  
Should we introduce a billet system whereby people can volunteer to house and sponsor a refugee family? There is already a chronic shortage of affordable and crisis housing for the Australian homeless and needy of our society.

Whilst many see as a noble cause to increase refugee intake, Australian taxpayers and residents deserve these serious questions to be answered. A pledge to the United Nations of \$500,000,000 - five hundred million dollars would build a lot of Public Housing.
