Dear Electoral Commission

Renaming of the Federal Electorate of Denison

I am writing to:

- (a) Support the proposal to rename the Federal electorate of Denison to recognise the contributions of Andrew Inglis Clark; and
- (b) Urge the Electoral Commission to re-name the electorate 'Inglis Clark' to ensure the distinct identification of Andrew Inglis Clark.

It appears the Commission has received sufficient and persuasive submissions on the appropriateness of renaming the electorate and, as such, I do not seek to make any submissions on this aspect.

In relation to the name to be adopted, I urge the Commission to adopt a name that is instantly recognisable as referring to Andrew Inglis Clark. In general discussion and writing, it is common for him to be referred to as Inglis Clark. Further, while I understand his family name was Clark that name alone much less readily identifies the significant figure in Tasmanian and Australian history that Andrew Inglis Clark was.
