I submit that Clark's name ranks with Parkes (NSW), Griffith (Qld), Barton (NSW) and Deakin (Vic) and ahead of Reid (NSW), Kingston (SA) and Forrest (WA) as a founding father of the Australian federation. Yet each of these others has an electoral division named in his honour. Clark's contribution to his home state was also immense as attorney-general and judge, principally as a law reformer.
