'Objection' to the proposal of the augmented Electoral Commission to rename the federal Division of Denison to 'Clark'.

As a former Tasmanian, I strongly approve the proposal to rename the federal Division of Denison to that of 'Clark'.

The proposed renaming would amount to timely recognition of the outstanding contribution of Andrew Inglis Clark to the political, legislative and judicial life of Tasmania, and above all, of his role as the primary architect of the Australian Constitution. Such recognition would go some way to redressing the lack of recognition in the federal capital itself, where Clark is merely acknowledged, together with one of his sons, and by his middle name only, by way of a cul-de-sac in a Canberra suburb. I warmly commend the proposal.
