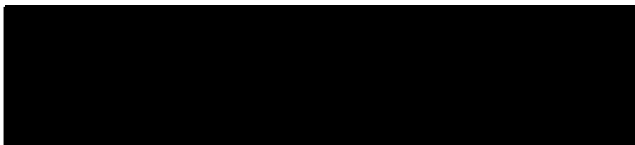
I write in relation to Submission 198 to the South Australia Federal Redistribution by Mr Tony Zappia MP, Federal Member for Makin and suggestions made in the submission proposing Makin's growth include the western areas of Salisbury.

The suburbs of Brahma Lodge, Salisbury Plain, Salisbury Park and Salisbury have remained in Wakefield and in its predecessor seat of Bonython since 1955 and always maintained a strong connection with the northern suburbs community.

Residents of the western areas of Salisbury are strongly connected with the northern suburbs through employment, education, sporting and community life.

The boundary between the electorates of Makin and Wakefield (and prior to that Bonython) has consistently been Main North Road, south of the Little Para River.
