To whom it may concern.

We understand that you are currently considering making changes to the electoral boundaries of federal electorates like our electorate of Boothby & we understand that some submissions to the Australian Electoral Commission have suggested moving the suburbs of Happy Valley, Aberfoyle Park and Flagstaff Hill, into the federal electorates of Mayo and Kingston which stretch down to Kangaroo Island and Noarlunga, Christie's Beach and Sellicks Beach respectively.

We are residents of Aberfoyle Park and are writing to put forward our submission that we strongly oppose moving our suburb and also Happy Valley and Flagstaff Hill into either Mayo or Kingston, which stretch down to Kangaroo Island and Noarlunga, Christie's Beach and Sellicks Beach respectively.

We know there are natural environmental boundaries that separate the federal electorates of Boothby and Kingston through the areas that include Glenthorne Farm, O'Halloran Hill Recreation Park and Happy Valley Reservoir. Similarly for Boothby and Mayo the areas of Aberfoyle Park and Happy Valley are the edge of suburban Adelaide while Mayo is centred on country areas in the Hills.

We believe this would substantially disrupt our community in Boothby and that our southern boundary as it stands now is ideal in maintaining our federal electorate as one centred on the southern and inner southern suburbs of Adelaide.
