I hereby emphasise my preference for an electorate to retain an Aboriginal name.

If Corangamite requires renaming then Barrabool is an appropriate alternative given the Barrabool tribe existed within the current boundary of Corangamite and the new proposed boundary. The Shire of Barrabool was named after the Barrabool tribe and Barrabool hills which is one of seven distinctive landscapes within Victoria. The Victorian government under Premier Jeff Kennett amalgamated councils and Barrabool became part of Surf Coast Shire. The new Shire of Corangamite continued the Corangamite name and heritage. Naming the new electorate from Corangamite to Barrabool would continue acknowledging the Barrabool tribe and assisting in the continuing of the reconciliation process between Aboriginal and non Aboriginal Australians.

I write this submission as a private citizen who is a former Shire of Barrabool councillor and current councillor at the Surf Coast Shire.
