Hello.

I am objecting to the proposed boundary redistribution for the following reasons:

- North Sydney is set to grow with the new metro station and development under the TOD SEPP, and a seat in this location is both desirable and will likely shrink over time
- the electorate represents a coherent and contiguous group that has a long established identity and voting priorities. Splitting us among many suburban seats dilutes this current inherent logic
- it is likely that in the future with the creation of Bradfield City in Western Sydney a new focused electorate around that city will be required. Logically, if Bradfield was abolished now, it could be re-created contiguous with "Bradfield City" in the future, and avoid the likely confusion of a federal electorate remote from a major city with the same name.
