I write in support of the proposed electoral redistribution of the seat of Warringah.

While the call was for objections, I feel it worth noting that there will be other objections to this redistribution and the abolition of the seat of North Sydney, so a counterargument is worth posting.

The new electoral boundaries for Warringah get rid of the current artificial division of the suburbs of the Lower North Shore (Neutral Bay, Cremorne, Mosman) that align along Military Road and share common issues with transport access, recreational facilities, and housing affordability. The unification of these suburbs in a single seat makes demographic sense and is long overdue.

The combination with the voters of Manly and the Lower Northern Beaches also makes sense, as we have common concerns managing access and over-exploitation of the harbour and ocean foreshores, as well as common transport access issues. Together we share a love for our environment, beaches, health and education.

I commend the AEC for the proposed new boundaries of Warringah and can't see a way to improve the current proposal.
