## Objections to Electoral; Redistribution of North Sydney Electorate

I am a long-term resident of Cremorne and strongly object to the AEC's proposal to redistribute our electorate to adjoining electorates for the following reasons –

- 1. North Sydney is a founding electorate with a long tradition and proud history of community based representation both at State and Federal levels. Few, if any, other electorates would have this. There is a danger that splitting the electorate and distribution to adjoining electorates would destroy that strong sense of community.
- 2. The projected population growth in the electorate would suggest there would be a strong case for reestablishing the electorate in a decade's time and at what cost to our community (see 1).
- 3. The business centre is one of the largest in Australia and demands an economic and cultural focus to reinforce its importance to the nation.
- 4. We do not share the needs or wants of adjoining electorates. Warringah and Bradfield are largely residential, light industry and low rise.
