Subject: Abolition of the federal seat of North Sydney

My name is Auvik Pal and am currently a resident of Lavender Bay in the federal seat of North Sydney. I have grown up in Artarmon and Lane Cove, and my father still lives in Lane Cove North. All in the federal seat of North Sydney.
