I write to object to the draft plans to abolish the federal seat of North Sydney in the proposed 2024 NSW redistribution and instead I support:

- 1. Keeping the divisions of both Warringah and North Sydney, and

My wife and I have lived in both electorates over the last 35 years.

The proposed dissolution of the North Sydney electorate would significantly disrupt a highly engaged community, undermining both democratic participation and community cohesion.

I realise that changing electorate boundaries is tricky, and it's a matter of compromise to achieve fairness and electoral equity. I recognize that with 24 NSW seats under quota, a significant redistribution affecting numerous seats is necessary. Given the complexity of this issue, I appreciate that the committee has considered various options for seat abolition. However, I respectfully urge the committee to re-examine alternative solutions that preserve both the North Sydney and Warringah seats. These electorates have demonstrated exceptional civic engagement and community cohesion, which are valuable assets to our democratic process.
