Re: PROPOSED REDISTRIBUTION OF FEDERAL ELECTORAL DIVISIONS IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

The WA Branch of the Australian Nursing & Midwifery Federation, the largest organisation for nurses and midwives in Australia, fully supports the recent proposal by the Australian Electoral Commission to rename an electoral boundary in Western Australia to "Bullwinkel," in honour of Lieutenant Colonel Vivian Bullwinkel AO MBE ARRC ED FNM FRCNA (1915–2000).

This renaming recognises Bullwinkel's extraordinary contributions as a civilian and military nurse, her resilience as the sole survivor of the 1942 Bangka Island massacre, and her dedication to honouring victims of war crimes and serving the nursing community.

Her survival and actions during and after the Bangka Island massacre highlight her incredible courage.
