**Details:** I'm completely against the proposed new boundaries especially in relation to Clark. Hobart is a capital city which naturally has a larger proportion of the population. Having a small electorate for the capital city makes sense. The new divisions split the greater Hobart city into three electorates diluting the voices of capital city residents. If the new divisions are mainly trying to fix the issue of Franklin being split, a better option would be Clark as proposed, but Franklin taking in the Northern Suburbs and the Eastern Shore (including Bridgewater and Brighton) while leaving the East Coast within Lyons. That way, Franklin would be an electorate of outer Hobart suburbs and Lyons stays as a purely regional focused electorate.
