I think the redistribution is not well thought out at all. Geographically it may seem to make sense, but Tasmania is a small state with strong communities, and these are strongly reflected within our current electoral boundaries. The proposed changes would divide these communities, and the current proposal has not taken Tasmania's unique demographics and political culture into account. For example, in my electorate of Clark, it makes complete sense as the boundaries stand currently. Taking out Glenorchy and adding the Southern part of the current electorate of Franklin as is being proposed, strongly suggests that the AEC has not consulted on the ground or have an understanding of the communities that encompass these regions, and how they lack an understanding of how the demographics of these towns/cities/local government areas are closely linked to the strong sense of community that is across this island and reflected within its electoral

boundaries. It is also disappointing to that it has not been taken into consideration that the State Electoral Boundaries would also change if the proposed was to go ahead. Has the TEC been consulted? This whole process feels like people in an office have drawn up lines on a map and looking and population numbers, rather than taking into account the deep and rich culture that is found amongst every inch of this island state and is strongly reflected in its electoral boundaries. I am strongly against this proposal as it currently stands. The only part that makes sense are Bass including outer suburbs. I would recommend adding a sixth electorate that encompasses the east coast and the Tasman peninsula, that would reduce the size of Lyons and Braddon and expand Clark to Brighton and the City of Clarence LGA and Franklin towards the West.
