Here's an idea - don't do it! I reside in the city of Glenorchy, currently in the electorate of Clark (formerly Denison). This is an urban area. It is no way aligned with either geographically or demographically with the electorate of Lyons. In your Redistribution Report regarding integrating Prospect Vale and Blackstone Heights, the AEC states, "The Committee also noted that transferring Blackstone Heights and Prospect Vale would consolidate the Launceston urban area within Bass, recognising that these localities are closely integrated with Launceston." Yet, despite this the AEC has decided that cleaving Glenorchy, a city contiguous with the City of Hobart, both highly urban areas, into a rural electorate is acceptable. It is not! It is completely unacceptable. This smacks more of Federal Special Minister of State Don Farrell's desire to remove Independent members and members representing minor parties within the Federal Parliament. This redistribution is
