Idea: Boundaries

**Details:** It will improve visibility of matters that are important to voters within

electorates, plus improve management of electorates, if all 5 levels of government have the same electoral boundaries: federal upper house,

federal lower house, state upper house, state lower house, local

government. If we have 5 electorates within tas, policies and governance can align through the levels of government, and both elected members and non-elected decision-making staff (eg council managers) can both take more responsibility and be able to be held responsible for matters within

their electorate. Now, the transition to align local government with parliamentary electorates is a massive step from the current situation, so

this proposal suggests that for local governance, each parliamentary electorate may have 3-5 local government areas within them. Thats a big
