It is wonderful to see in-depth feedback on the redistribution proposal.

I am heartened by broad support in the published suggestions for retaining Crace in Fenner, and Macquarie in Canberra. I hope to see this go forward in the amended redistribution proposal.

I would like to lend my support to consideration of the extensive and well thought through proposal from Anonymous 2. In addition to retaining Crace and Macquarie in their existing electorates, it also deals with expansion in Molonglo Valley thoughtfully and provides a good alternative that solves many of the issues being grappled with by those involved in the redistribution process.

I also support uniting all of Jerrabomberra in the electorate of Canberra per the submission from Anonymous 6. Residents of Symonston have closer transport links to Canberra than to Bean, and have some similar interests to residents of Oaks Estate and other smaller communities in the eastern ACT.

I am also convinced by the arguments from local residents for retaining all of Duffy in the southernmost electorate. Duffy would be the only major suburb split by this proposed redistribution and it makes much more sense to keep it all within one electorate.
