My Approach

I like to draw electoral boundaries which:

- follow geographical features
- follow other electoral boundaries (state or local government)
- follow first nations country boundaries
- have a low projected enrollment deviation (between $\pm 1.00\%$)

Electorate name suggestion

I would like to suggest renaming the seat of Adelaide to Tarntanya

This change would mean South Australia does have a federal seat with an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander origin

It would also reduce duplication with the State Lower House Seat of Adelaide which shares an identical name. Currently there is ambiguity over “your candidate for Adelaide / elected MP for Adelaide”

Boundary Redrawing suggestions

Grey

Add suburbs of Buchfelde, Gawler Belt and Hewett from Spence. This follows existing Local government boundaries and the new State boundaries.

Barker

Remove all of Light Regional Council and Barossa Council

Add Strathalbyn, Goolwa, Port Elliot and surrounding areas from Mayo

Mayo

Add all parts of Light Regional Council and Barossa Council removed from Barker

Remove areas from Victor Harbor to Strathalbyn to Barker

Remove suburbs of Coromandel Valley and Craighburn Farm to Kingston and Boothby divided by the Sturt River

Kingston

Add portion of Coromandel Valley in the Onkaparinga Council local government area / South of the Sturt river / Warriparri

Boothby

Add Craighburn Farm and the portion of Coromandel Valley in the Mitcham Council local government area / North of the Sturt River / Warriparri

Sturt

Add suburb of Vista and portion of St Agnes within Tolley Road, Smart Road, Hancock Road and Grand Junction Road

Makin

Remove Vista and portion of St Agnes to Sturt

Gain all areas south of the Little Para River from Spence e.g. Salisbury South, Brahma Lodge, Salisbury Plain, Salisbury Park, Salisbury Downs, Salisbury

Spence

Remove suburbs of Buchfelde, Gawler Belt and Hewett into Grey

Remove all areas south of the Little Para River to Makin

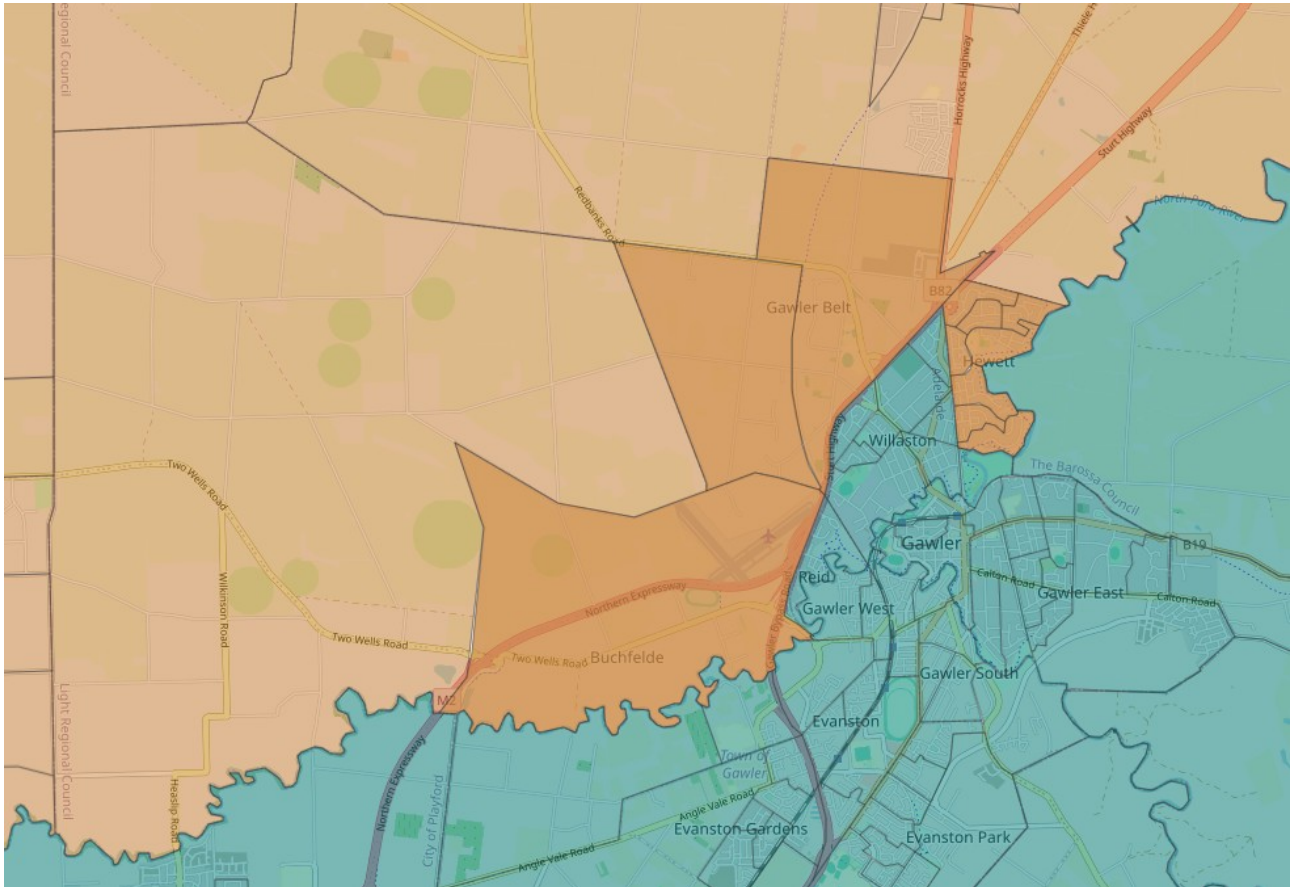
Adelaide/Tarntanya, Hindmarsh

Visualising my ideas / proposed borders

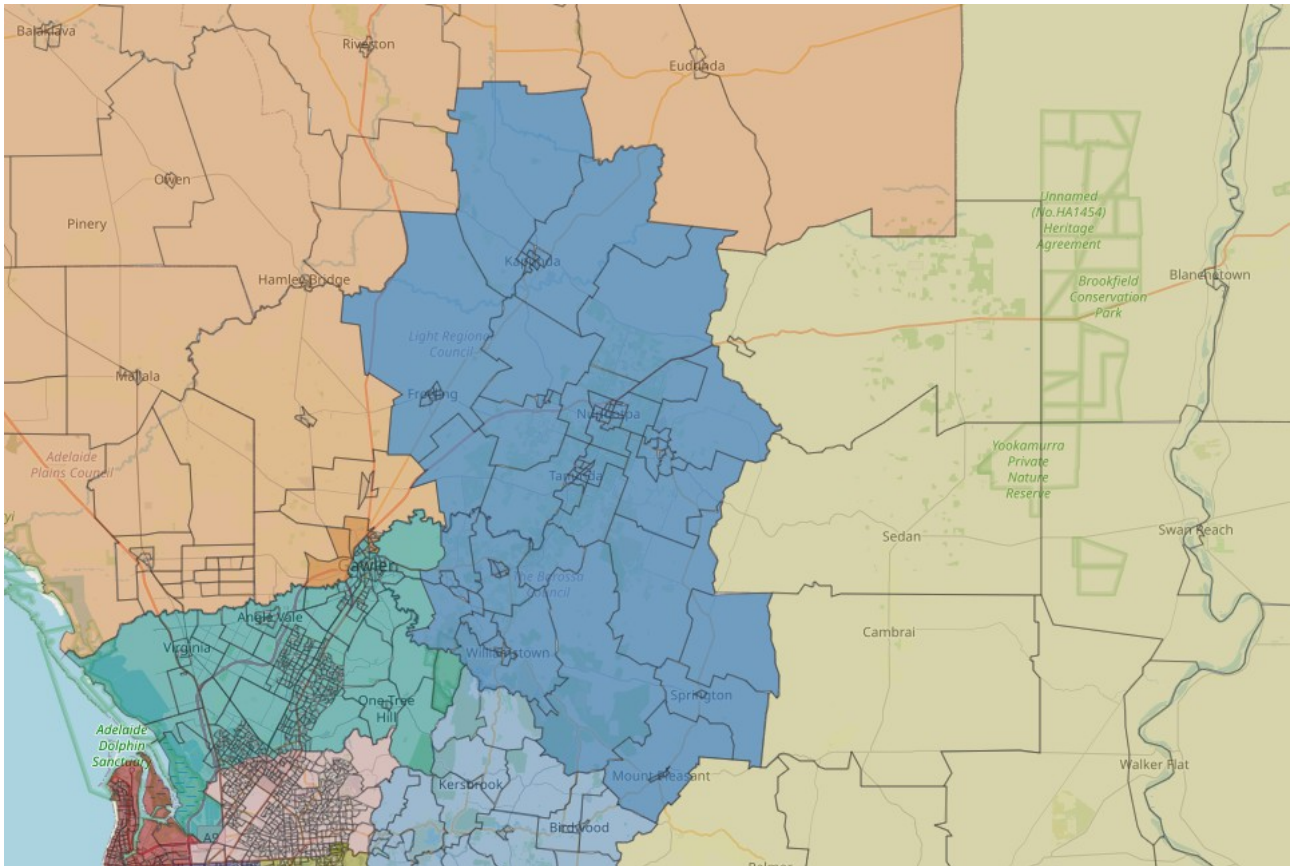
Grey (orange) / Spence (teal)

This proposed border would be in line with local council and new state electoral district boundaries



Barker (yellow) / Mayo (steel blue)

Transfer all of Light Regional Council and Barossa Council from Barker into Mayo



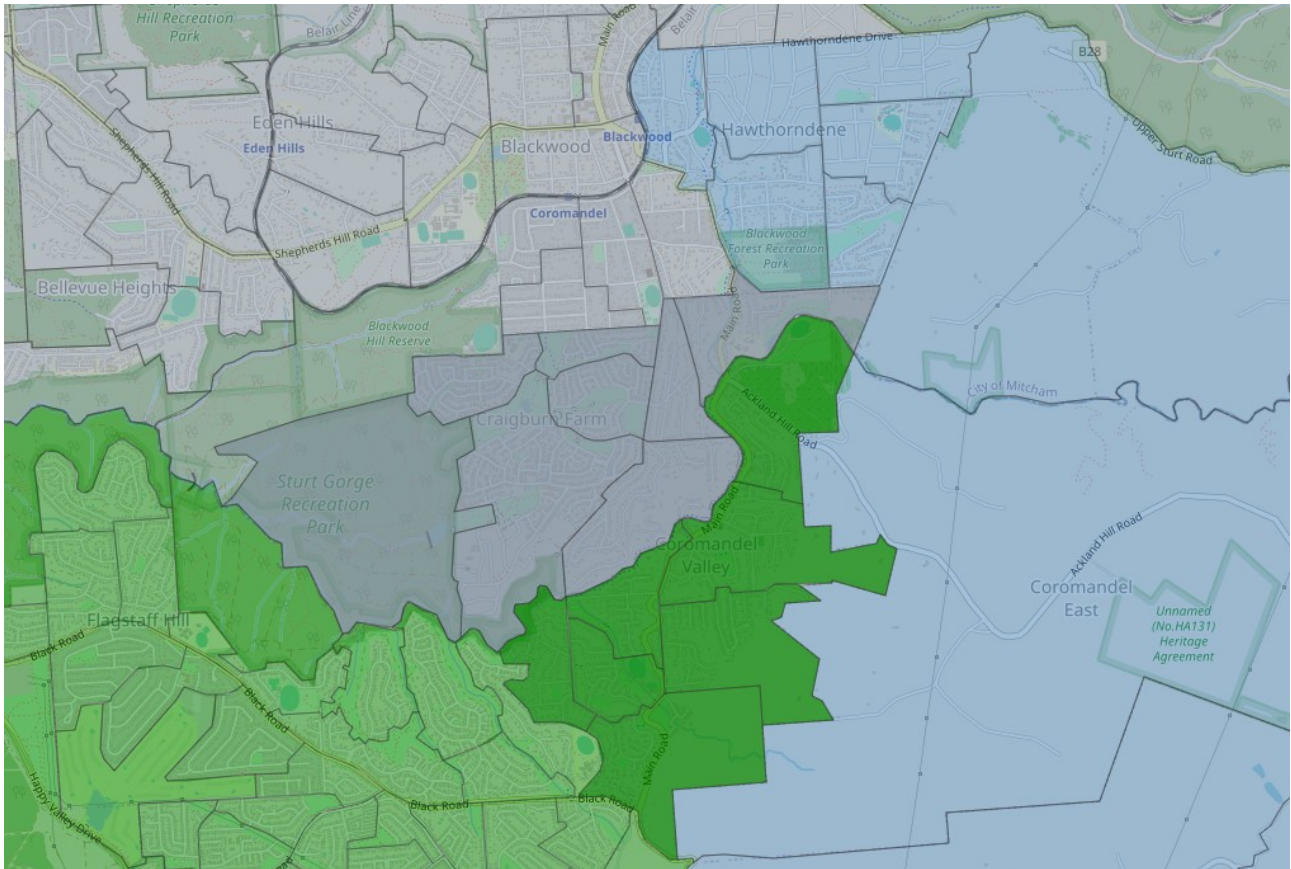
Transfer Strathalbyn, Goolwa, Port Elliot and surrounding areas from Mayo into Barker



This redraws the border between Barker and Mayo along the Eastern slope of the Mount Lofty Ranges. This would mean Barker doesn't cross the Mt Lofty Ranges, most Ngarrindjeri land together in Barker, unites the viticulture regions north and south of urban Adelaide into Mayo.

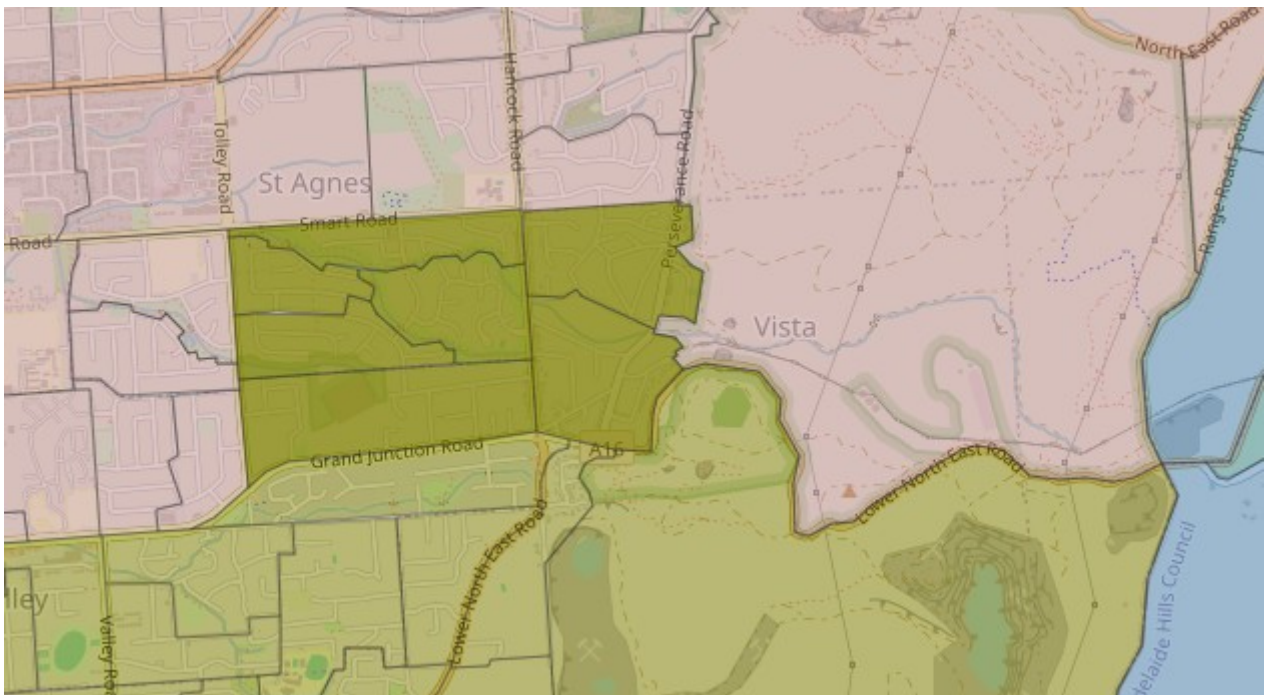
Mayo (steel blue) / Kingston (green) / Boothby (grey)

Mayo transfers most of it's urban suburbs to Kingston and Boothby, with only Hawthorndene remaining in Mayo.



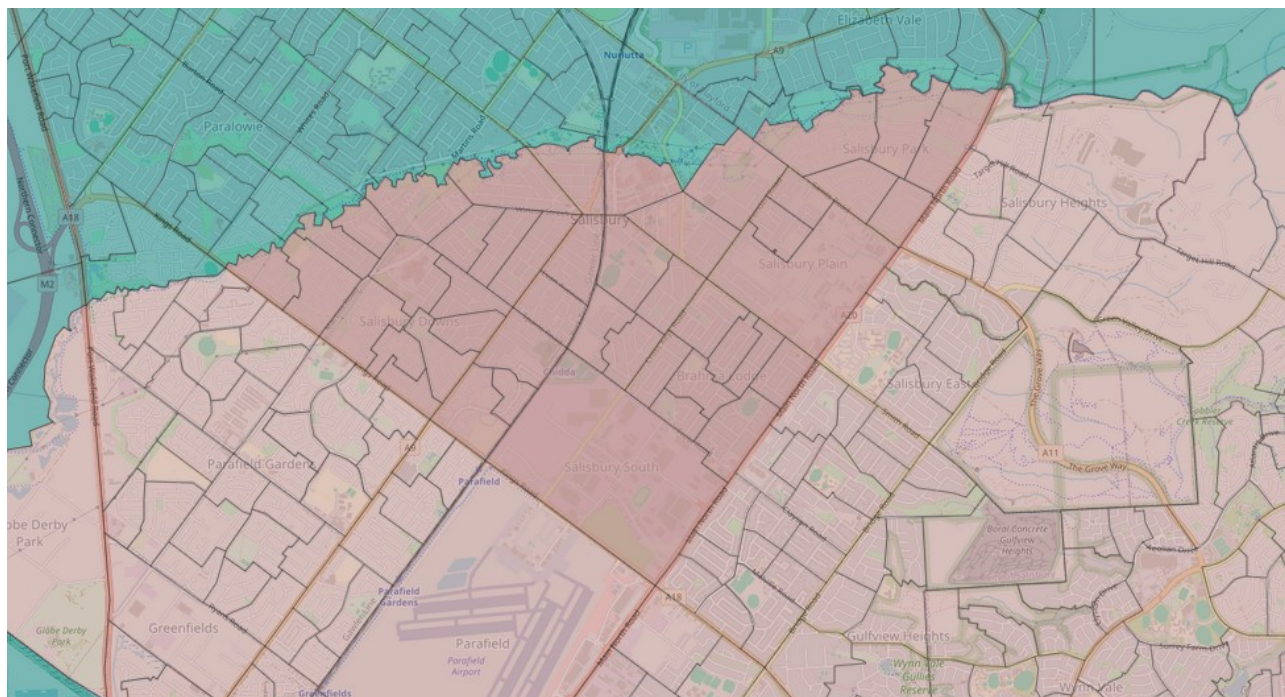
Sturt (yellow) / Makin (pink)

Add suburb of Vista and portion of St Agnes within Tolley Road, Smart Road, Hancock Road and Grand Junction Road.



Makin (pink) / Spence (teal)

Gain all areas south of the Little Para River from Spence e.g. Salisbury South, Brahma Lodge, Salisbury Plain, Salisbury Park, Salisbury Downs, Salisbury
