This year a referendum will be held on whether to alter the Constitution to recognise the First Peoples of Australia by establishing an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice.

The last referendum was held in 1999. It's the only way the Constitution can be changed. The Constitution sets out how Australia is governed.

All Australian citizens aged 18 and over must vote, and the government must act on what Australia decides.
